## What is the Janian Consumer Advisory Board?







- Established in 2012 with participants from CUCS' Career Network
- Group consists of 8-10 people with lived experiences of homelessness and mental health conditions, who previously received Janian services or are currently receiving services
- Meet monthly for an hour & quarterly outreach events

#### How do you become a member?

- Members are referred from other CAB participants, programs, psychiatrists, primary care staff, and social service worker
- All potential candidates must apply and complete the interview process



#### What is CAB's Mission?

#### The initial mission of CAB has 4 tenets:

- 1. Provide feedback about healthcare
- 2. Provide expert consultations when Janian proposes new programming
- 3. Advocacy for the community
- 4. Member's Defined Mission:
  - Grand Round presentations- using opportunities to expand CAB's reach by speaking to a large group of varying providers
  - Outreach Events- giving back to the community

#### **CAB Accomplishments!!!**

- •Trained more than 2,600 people who were experiencing homeless in harm reduction techniques; along with providing mental healthy screenings and referrals, and offering peer support
- Presented at 10 Grand Rounds
- Recipient of the PPOH Teaching Award
- •Recipient of The National Service Award presented by Dr. Anne Sullivan- Commissioner of the NY State Office of Mental Health
- Presented at the American Psychiatric Association Mental Health Services Conference
- Inspired the formation of other CABs across NYC (e.g Breaking Ground)
- •CAB members currently participate in agency-wide CUCS Quality Assurance meetings and Janian's Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Committee
- •In February 2025, CAB members presented at a summit on Psychiatric Advanced Directive's (PADS) and its implementation in NY State
  - NY State is in the process of taking action steps to ensure that PADS is more widely available for patients
